Voluntary Contributions and Charges Schedule for 2023

Dear Families

Each year all parents are requested to make a number of payments towards their child's education. These payments include Voluntary Contributions, Charges and Personal Use Items. This letter is to explain the costs that you can expect to incur throughout the year. This transparency in disclosing the maximum anticipated cost to parents is a key feature of the School Education Act / Regulations and Department of Education Policy and has been approved by the O'Connor Education Support Centre School Council.

1. Voluntary Contributions
